### GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE ISLE OF MAN

The Isle of Man is in the Irish Sea, approximately 60 miles from England's Fylde coast in Lancashire, 12 miles from Scotland's Galloway coast, 104 miles from Belfast in Northern Ireland and 104 miles from Dublin in the Republic of Ireland. The coastline of North Wales is also within easy sailing distance. Every one of these countries except Wales has direct transport connections to the Isle of Man by sea or by air or in some cases both. The Isle of Man has a population of just over 75,000. The capital Douglas, where over 25,000 people reside, is located on the east coast of the island.

The summers are cool with clear skies. The winters are mild and wet. The island does not suffer with overcast skies as much as other places in the British Isles. The strong winds which whip through the island keep the clouds moving.

Average low/high for September is 12/16 degrees C.
